

Northland Chiefs Cheerleading Fees

**ONE HALF OF EACH CHILD'S FEES ARE DUE AT SIGN UPS
THE REMAINING BALANCE IS DUE NO LATER THAN AUGUST 12th.**

All cheerleading fees include the use of a uniform (vest, skirt, turtleneck and spankies) which will be returned at the end of the season. This fee includes the cost of insurance for each cheerleader which is required by the Northland Suburban Youth Football League. Fees also include ticket(s) to our annual Texas Holdem fundraiser. Date TBA. Flag cheerleaders receive 1 ticket with their paid fees. Tackle cheerleaders receive 2 tickets with their paid fees. Tickets may be resold for \$40 each.

In addition to league/team fees, cheerleaders will be responsible for the following:

Sneakers:

Cheer shoes for Flag and 3rd/4th graders. Approx. \$22

Cheer shoes for 5th/6th and 7th/8th graders. Approx. \$35

Purchased cheerleading shoes belong to the cheerleader. New shoes are purchased at the beginning of each year. Returning cheerleaders may use last season's shoes for practice. Sneakers will be worn to EVERY practice. You may choose to designate a pair for practice and a pair for games. Game day shoes are expected to be CLEAN.

Warm Ups:

Each squad has a required warm up which includes a jacket and/or pants. Cheerleaders are required to purchase the designated warm up for her squad. Warm up costs range between \$40 and \$50. Warm ups are yours to keep.

Homecoming:

Every year, the Northland Chiefs have a Homecoming celebration. As a part of that celebration, cheerleaders are required to make a poster for themselves to be hung as decoration at the

football field. Posters range in cost depending upon design. Posters are yours to keep at the end of Homecoming.

Cheerleaders are also required to donate 1 **LARGE** bag of candy to be handed out to each player/cheerleader on Homecoming Day. (no chocolate candy please)

Water/Pop/Gatorade Donations:

Each player and cheerleader is required to donate the following:

Flag cheerleaders and football players: 1 case of 20oz Gatorade bottles

3rd and 4th Grade cheerleaders and football players: 1 case of 20oz Gatorade bottles

5th and 6th Grade cheerleaders and football players: 2 cases of bottled water

7th and 8th Grade cheerleaders and football players: 2 cases of 20oz Gatorade bottles
